

FIELD REGULATIONS & POLICIES

The following are Field Regulations from the parks and school district that BYSA uses. BYSA pays for the use of most of these fields; we need your help to pass along these regulations so BYSA can continue the privilege of using these fields. These Regulations pertain to both PRACTICES and GAMES.

Please make sure to share these policies and stress the importance of following the regulations with all your Coaches, Managers, Parents, and Team Players:

Radisson Fields:

- **NO ANIMALS ALLOWED**
- Park, fields, and unlighted courts close at dark
- Do not park on the fields. Use parking lots first, then if needed, park on the field side of the street only.
- Fields should not be used if soil conditions are extremely wet or if excessive standing water is present on the infields. Fields are inspected weekly April – October, please notify the BYSA Registrar at Registrar@bvillesoccer.com if you have any concerns.
- Please dispose of litter in trash receptacles, a fee may be charged if excessive clean-up is required after use of fields.
- Alcoholic consumption is not allowed

Baldwinsville Schools:

- **NO ANIMALS ALLOWED**
- Park vehicles in parking lot areas only. Do not park on fields, grass, sidewalks, or pathways.

Lysander Parks (Spence Field- *Saturday U12/14 Games*):

- **NO ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED**
- No Smoking allowed
- Coaches must stay until all players have been pick up by a parent or guardian
- Please keep park clean, place garbage in trash cans
- Notify park staff of any accidents or of any damage to building or grounds
- No alcoholic beverages
- No food or drink on any paved courts
- Foul language will not be tolerated
- The park is not responsible for lost or stolen property
- No glass bottles or objects are allowed in the playground area
- Park only on parking lots, not on grass, walkways, or jogging path.
- Activities not allowed in the park: soliciting, use of firearms or explosive devices, golf, use of rockets, remote control planes or any other airborne devices, and open fires.
- Restrooms close 15 minutes prior to the park closing for cleaning.
